

AGREEMENT

between

I. INTRODUCTION

JA-YE Italy is a not for profit organization that develops and promotes educational programs aimed at transferring basic skills and knowledge to the school to develop employability and ensure a better quality of life to young people, and made them actively contributing to the future economic, social and cultural of their communities. Since 2003, with the support of companies, foundations, institutions and business professionals, JA-YE reached and trained more than 115,000 students in primary, secondary and high schools all over Italy. JA-YE Italy is a partner of JA-YE Europe, the pan-European network based in Brussels that brings together 38 national organizations every year and reaches more than 3.1 million students, and Junior Achievement Worldwide, the largest and oldest not for profit organization in the world for the promotion of Economics in school.

Fondazione Sodalitas, founded in 1995 by Assolombarda, the largest association in Confindustria territorial system, to build a bridge between business and society, was the first organization that introduced in Italy the concept of Corporate Sustainability. Fondazione Sodalitas is sustained by 83 leader companies, employing 753,000 people and representing 25% of GDP. Fondazione Sodalitas is the Italian partner of the European Union for the implementation of the Agenda on Sustainability and, since 1995, is officially representing in our country the CSR Europe's network, made up of companies committed to the european integration of sustainability in business.

II. OBJECT OF THE AGREEMENT

The object of this agreement is the common interest of the Contracting Parties to the entrepreneurial education programs and orientation to work in high schools. JA-YE Italy holds the program "Company Programme", already active in about 100 Italian high schools, and the subject of experimentation and study within the project "Student Company" (European Program "Leonardo da Vinci" - Lifelonglearning Programme 2007-2013). The S.C. project studies the Norwegian approach for the establishment of a mini-company of students and aims to develop an action plan on entrepreneurship in education to reach in the medium-long term. JA-YE Italy worked coordinated the establishment and management of the student company called "Remember" and made up of a group of students (aged between 15 and 18 years) in a position of social disadvantage, participating in the Project for Education and Training "Administrative Secretary" supported by the Organization Unisco and the Calamandrei High School in Bari.

Fondazione Sodalitas has undertaken since 2000 the project "Giovani & Impresa" to guide young people in the delicate period of transition from school to work. Direct beneficiaries of the initiative are the higher schools and universities. The project offers many free training opportunities for integration of traditional and educational programs focused on issues such as work culture and entrepreneurship, social responsibility, education to the economy as a social value system.

III. PURPOSES OF THE AGREEMENT

This agreement aims to establish a collaboration between JA-YE Italy and Fondazione Sodalitas as a follow up after the experimentation carried out under the project "Student Company" referred to in section II of this paper.

In particular, the objective is the structuring of a mutual cooperation to include, in particular the sharing of the results derived from experiments made by JA-YE Italy within the project "Student Company" within a group of drop-out students.

In order to achieve this objectives and new activities that may arise in future, the parties will establish contractual agreements separate and specific mode through which regulate the cooperation and the rights, obligations and conditions for the implementation of activities in question.

IV. CONFIDENTIALITY

In order to achieve good cooperation, the Parties will agree on the content information and project results will be made public, respecting the principle of confidentiality of information acquired during the implementation of this agreement that each side able to indicate as confidential.

V. FINAL PROVISIONS

For the implementation of the commitments and activities under this agreement, the Parties agree to maintain regular and frequent contact for the evaluation and implementation of individual activities.

The Contracting Parties, after the signing of this agreement, will undertake to achieve the tasks assigned to an operational level, and to propose new forms of cooperation or procedures for implementing the existing project and the ongoing cooperation.

This agreement has no expiration date and is concluded for an indefinite period of time may be terminated unilaterally by either party by notifying the other party.

This protocol does not require any fee or exclusively borne by the Contracting Parties, any other agreement, including economic and executive joint actions will be governed by subsequent agreements, protocols or conventions.
